



*****Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series Adds MEGA 100 to the schedule of events*****

Glasgow, KY (February 16, 2018)- Officials with the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series and track owner's Cody Watson & John Watson are excited to announce the tour will be making its first ever stop to Tyler County Speedway located in Middlebourne, WV on May 31st – June 2nd to be a part of the MEGA 100 weekend. This is one of the biggest weekends for modified racing with over \$60,000.00 to be paid out over the 3-day event and Saturday night's A-Main winner receiving \$15,000.00 for his/her efforts and \$700.00 to start the competition.

Series President Jeff Crawford stated "I want to thank Cody for contacting us to give us the opportunity to be a part of this prestigious event and also I want thank Michael Daugherty of Kickapoo and Daugherty speedway's for moving there schedule around to accommodate us for this great opportunity. Also Crawford stated "with our new format of racing this year this gives us the flexibility to add marquee events to our schedule that may not be in our core area's of racing but provide a great opportunity for more exposure for our series, drivers and fans." Tyler County Speedway now operates under the UMP tire rule and also will be removing the spoilers for this event to allow UMP racers to support this event with little changes to be made. While all the details have not been completely finished yet we would like to give a brief overview of the events with more information to come next week along with lodging information.

May 31st Thursday-

Will be an invitational race that will involve current and past points champions and competitors of the AMS, UMP, AMRA and UEMS. This event will consist of qualifying, heat races and the A-Main. The winner will earn a guaranteed provisional starting spot in the MEGA 100 A-Main Feature.

The sponsor for this event is still in the works and the amount to win and start is also to be determined.

June 1st Friday-

Will consist of qualifying, heat races and twin features with positions based on a passing points format. This will also set the top 10 positions for the MEGA 100 A-main feature with all other competitors to transfer to a B-Main on Saturday night.

June 2nd – Saturday

There will be four 'Qualifiers' B-Mains lined up based on Friday's feature results. Each 'Qualifier' will be 10 laps. The top three from each 'Qualifier' will advance (Spots 11-22) in the A- Main. There will be a 15 car 'Last Chance Showdown' with the top two advancing to the A-Main (Spots 23-24). There will be 1 MEGA qualifier provisional (Spot 25). (Spot 26) will be auctioned to highest bidder. (Spot 27) will be the AMS Series provisional. (Spot 28) will be the winner of Thursday night's A-Main. Saturday's "MEGA" Finale A-Main will be 50 laps and pay the winner \$15,000.00 to win and \$700.00 to start.
