Tyler Nicely Captures Summit Racing Equipment AMS Victory at Cedar Ridge Speedway

The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series would visit the Cedar Ridge Speedway in Morgantown, KY Saturday night. Tyler Nicely from Owensboro, KY would guide his #25 Elite Chassis entry to victory lane and collect the \$2,000 pay day!

Brandon McDowell and Tyler Nicely would lead the field to green on a beautiful night in central Kentucky. The front row starting duo would race door-to-door on the opening lap that would eventually see Nicely obtain the lead off turn four to complete lap-1. The event's first caution would be for the damaged machine of Robbie Sanders on lap-5 that would tighten the field once again. Bad luck would strike Richie Lex as his night would come to an early end on the lap-5 restart due to apparent mechanical issues. Back to racing action, Nicely would once again maintain his spot in front but the field would be slowed on lap-7 for the stalled machine of Kevin Pedigo. On the lap-7 restart, racing action did not last long as Trent Young and Brian Shaw would make contact prompting the event's final caution. Nicely would once again maintain his strangle hold on the top spot on the restart and would begin to pull away from the field. Josh Harris would move into the second position during the mid-point of the feature event but his night would come to an early end due to mechanical issues. Nicely would never be challenged during the feature event and would take his 1st series victory of the 2019 season. Brandon McDowell would take runner-up honors followed by Jimmy Payne. Gabriel Kirtley would claim fourth and Brian Shaw would rally back from his early spin to complete the top five.

The remainder of the top ten at the completion of the Summit Racing Equipment A-Main at Cedar Ridge Speedway would be Matt Markham, Peyton Harlow, Chris Cole, Andy Elliott, and Mark Cole.

The next event for the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will be May 23rd at Tri City Speedway. The event will pay \$2,000.00 to the winner.
