Mike Harrison Tops Summit Racing Equipment AMS Action at Farmer City Raceway

The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series would visit the Farmer City Raceway in Farmer City, IL Friday night. Mike Harrison from Highland, IL would race his #24h Impressive Chassis entry to victory lane and collect the \$2,000 pay day!

Mike Harrison and Tyler Nicely would lead a strong field to green Friday night at Farmer City Raceway. Tyler Nicely would grab the early lead in the 30-lap A-Main event as Harrison would settle in the second position. Nicely and Harrison would quickly begin to separate themselves from the field in the early laps of the event. As the duo began to encounter lap traffic on lap-6, Harrison would quickly close the gap on Nicely and eventually grab the top-spot on lap-8. The event's first caution would fly on lap-11 as Mark Cole would make hard contact with the turn-3 wall. On the restart, Nicely was able to re-assume the lead from Harrison and once again distance themselves from the competition. The event's second and final caution slowed the event on lap-16 as the machine of Trevor Neville suffered heavy right-front suspension damage eventually coming to a stop in turn-1. Once again, Nicely would take control on the restart while Harrison would follow closely in second position. Nicely appeared to be in route for his second series victory of the 2019 season; however, Nicely would jump the turn one cushion on lap-21 that allowed Harrison to regain the lead and Allen Weisser would move into the second position. Weisser would slowly close in on Harrison in the final five laps. Weisser was able to pull along side Harrison coming to the finish but was unable to complete the pass. Harrison would score his first series victory of the 2019 season. Allen Weisser would finish in second, Michael Long would claim the third position, and Tyler Nicely and "Allstar Performance Hard Charger" Ray Bollinger would round out the top five.

The remainder of the top ten at the completion of the Summit Racing Equipment A-Main at Farmer City Raceway would be Danny Schwartz, Brian Shaw, Kenny Wallace, Jeff Leka, and Trent Young.

The next event for the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will be May 25th at Fairbury Speedway. The event will pay \$2,000.00 to the winner.
