Tyler County and Mansfield Up Next for the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series

The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will return to action with a massive weekend of racing action as the tour will visit Tyler County Speedway June 28th – 30th and Mansfield Motor Speedway on July 1st.

Tyler County Speedway's Mega 100 was originally set for early June 2018; however, unfavorable weather forecasts/conditions prompted series/track officials to postpone the event. As a result of the previous postponement, Tyler County Speedway and AMS officials have rescheduled the event for this upcoming weekend. America's Baddest Bullring has revamped the entire weekend schedule to make the weekend even more MEGA for fans and teams. The 7th Annual "Let It Ride 55", which was scheduled for June 30th after a May 2018 rain out will now be completed on Friday, June 29th and the 4th annual "Mega 100" will now be completed on June 30th.



Friday night's "Let It Ride 55" will feature a full program of practice, A-B group time trials, qualifying heat races, B-Mains, and the 55-lap, \$3,055 to win/\$255 to start A-main event. Saturday night's "Mega 100" will feature a full program of practice, A-B group time trials, qualifying heat races, B-Mains, and the 60-lap, \$15,000 to win/\$500 to start A-main event. Other divisions joining the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series on both nights will be ULMS Late Models, STARS Mod-Lites, EDGE Hotmod, and FWD 4 cylinders.

In addition to events stated above, Tyler County Speedway is hosting the Summit Racing Equipment "Sanction Shootout" that will be \$1000 to win/\$100 to start. Ten drivers from each of the organizations involved to participate this weekend will be invited to compete in the event. Drivers from AMS, Renegades of Dirt, Dirt Cup, Tyler County, AMRA, and UEMS will see up to 60 drivers competing in the non-point paying event. The event will run by pill draw heat races and a 20-lap A-main feature event with the winner also earning a guaranteed starting spot in the "Mega 100."

Following the huge event at Tyler County Speedway, the Summit Racing Equipment will cap off the massive weekend of racing at the Cody Sommer's Mansfield Motor Speedway on Sunday, July 1st for the "Freedom 30." The tour will be in competition with a full program of practice, A-B group time trials, qualifying heat races, B-Mains, and the 30-lap, \$5,000 to win/\$300 to start A-main event. Also competing with the Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series will be the stars of the Lucas Oil Late Model Dirt Series in a 50-lap \$12,000 to win main event.



Cody Watson from Tyler County Speedway and Cody Sommer from Mansfield Motor Speedway have partnered to establish a "Gold & Gray Bonus" that will include a \$2,000 bonus for a driver who can win any two nights or a \$5,000 bonus to any driver who can 'sweep the weekend' by winning all three shows. The culmination could lead to one modified team taking home an Eastern U.S. unheard of sum of \$28,000 dollars!

2018 Tire Rule

Under the guideline of the 2018 DIRTcar UMP Modified rules, only tires approved for DIRTcar competition are the **Hoosier: M-30S and M-60 compounds** in the DIRTcar plated tire 26.5/8.0/15 or 27.5/8.0/15. The maximum width of the tire will be 9 inches. **The M-60 may be used as a right rear option tire. NO GROOVING ALLOWED. Siping permitted on M-30 and M-60.**
