



McKinney Charges for Big Fairbury Win

(Sept 4, 2021) – The Summit Racing Equipment American Modified Series invaded the Fairbury Speedway for the biggest payday of the 2021 season. The Fairbury Speedway once again gave host to the \$10,000 to win Super Nationals.

A season high 63 cars signed in and looked to lay down the quickest lap in Allstar Performance qualifying. Curt Spalding was the overall quickest at 14.159 seconds from Group B. Cole Falloway of Owensboro, KY was quickest in Group A at 14.305 seconds. Qualifying set the lineups for six heat races.

In Hypercoils Heat Race #1 Cole Falloway picked up the heat race win over Derek Losh. Only the top two finishers moved on to the main event.

It was Treb Jacoby who came home with the win in Willy's Carb & Dyno Heat Race #2. Defending series champion Tyler Nicely came away runner up.

Mike Harrison won Fast Shafts Heat Race #3. Dylan Nusbaum finished second and also moved on to the main event.

In Heat #4 presented by Maxima Oil fast qualifier Curt Spalding got the win. Mark Lamont from Crossville, IL also got a transfer into the nights feature event.

Will Krup used the pole starting spot to win Heat #5. Brandon Bollinger charged from the seventh starting spot to get across the stripe second and make the big show.

Starting on the outside front row of Heat #6, Kenny Wallace came home the winner. Frank Marshall was able to best Victor Lee and Nick Hoffman to nab second and transfer to the \$10,000 to win feature event.

It took three VP Racing Fuel B-Mains to set the rest of the field. Garrett Jameson, Austin Friedman, and Will Bennett transferred from B-Main #1. Allen Weisser, Bobby Stremme, and Ethan Weber survived to move on from B-Main #2. Nick Hoffman, Bradley Jameson, and Victor Lee got the remaining spots in the feature event.

The fifty lap \$10,000 to win event started off with Cole Falloway out front. Cole would lead unit lap 12. On the twelfth lap Mike Harrison came from the 5th starting spot to take the lead. But only a couple of laps later Harrison slowed due to mechanical issues and his night was done.

On the restart Tyler Nicely would take the lead until the halfway point when Tyler got into the wall and ended his night. On the restart Cole Falloway regained the race lead. But it would be short lived as Nick Hoffman who started deep in the field took over the top spot as we got to lap 30.

On lap 35 the provisional starter Mike McKinney would overtake Nick Hoffman and hold him off in the final laps to pick up the biggest payday of his career. In victory lane, Mike talked about how bad they sucked earlier in the night and how crazy it was to get things turned around in the feature. Mike was emotional as he thanked his dad and sponsors. Post-race Mike said this was the coolest win of his career and being able to pass Nick Hoffman, the best in the business, made it even sweeter.

It was a rough night for American Modified Series point leaders. Tyler Nicely was the best finisher at 17th. Points leader Brian Shaw came home 23rd.
