Long time race director Tim Wolfe lost his life back earlier this fall and left a spot to be filled. Del will immediately take the responsibilities associated with the series position.

Del has a storied history in the racing community that will make him an instant impact to the series. Del has been a racer since 1972 when he got his start at the Decorah Iowa Speedway. In the 1990's Del moved to southern Indiana and worked for several late model teams. In 2005 Del signed on as the Technical Director for the Battle of the Bluegrass Late Model Series. He served for 2 years with the series before resuming as a crew member for more local late model teams.

Del will be retiring from his full-time job and will allow him to devote himself full time to the American Modified Series. Del says, "Racing needs a premier series, and my long-term vision is to move the AMS Series into the forefront of Modified racing. I personally thank Dewayne Ragland for this opportunity and looking forward to this next step in my career."
